授業の目標 (Course Objectives)

This course will provide a comprehensive introduction to Modernist Drama and focus specifically on Samuel Beckett's "Endgame." Further course objectives include improvement in discussion and writing skills and the acquisition of a much wider English vocabulary.

授業の内容 (Course Contents)

This course will give a full introduction to the drama of the major Irish writer Samuel Beckett (1906 – 1989). Discussion will include detailed accounts of Beckett's most famous dramatic works for the stage and for television, but will also consider broader definitions of literature and twentieth century artistic experimentation to help familiarise students with the central tenets of Modernism. The course will be supported by examining some of the numerous productions of Beckett's plays on DVD and online.
