#### 授業の目標 (Course Objectives)

This course aims to help students (1) understand the use of language in our daily interaction with others, (2) gain experiences in applying the concepts to analyzing real life situations, and (3) become better communicators in English by understanding effective and problematic use of verbal messages.

#### 授業の内容 (Course Contents)

In this class, we will discuss the use of language in our everyday interaction on the basis of theories and research in areas such as interpersonal communication, conversation analysis, and ethnography of communication. Topics to be covered include: metamesages to define our relationships, messages affecting our self-concepts, use of language in conflict situations, analysis of naturally occurring conversations, and American-Japanese interaction. By going back and forth between abstract concepts and concrete examples, we aim to have a better understanding of the ordinary use of language in our daily lives. The class is conducted in English. Students are required to actively engage in small group as well as class discussions, and make presentations of their analyses.
