#### 授業の目標 (Course Objectives)

To have an overall understanding of how the brain processes language  
 To understand key concepts in psycholinguistics  
 To become familiar with the main areas of research in psycholinguistics  
 To understand the potential relevance and usefulness of psycholinguistic knowledge

#### 授業の内容 (Course Contents)

This course introduces the field and basic concepts and knowledge of psycholinguistics. It provides an exploration of how the brain processes language as well as the ongoing research approaches to uncovering this knowledge. Following the outline of Paul Warren's book "Introducing Psycholinguistics" which will be used as the main textbook for this course, the course explores different aspects of psycholinguistics. As this is an introductory course, it is suitable for any students who have an interest in language, psychology, or the connection between them. The course will be taught in English so English sufficient to participate in an English based class with weekly readings in English is a necessary requirement. During the course, students will have opportunities to further explore areas that they are interested in. Although the course will aim to cover much of the textbook content, as introduced by the teacher, students will only be asked to read specific sections of it.
