- (iv) write short essays that combine personal, theoretical and research information on various aspects of individual differences.

This course will introduce a range of individual differences in human psychology, in particular regarding additional language learning. Drawing on theoretical perspectives and personal experiences, students will be encouraged to consider such dimensions as personality, identity, beliefs and agency, motivation, and emotions. The course will also touch upon the interaction of individual differences with group dynamics.
